annotate any thoughts, ideas and questions	provides a point of reference for future research and discussion
link new information to what you already know	facilitates both a global understanding of the topic and deeper learning
talk lectures over with others	promotes deeper thinking and learning and gives ideas for future note-taking techniques
file notes systematically as you make them	makes it easier to retrieve information
